Unique Restaurant Concept Offers Large Selection of Made-in-Oklahoma Foods, Arts and Crafts

Oklahoma City, Oklahoma April 1, 2021 --Oklahoma City residents can help celebrate the re-opening of our state by supporting local vendors and artisans with the unique vibe of Meridian Market Restaurant, a modern American eatery concept featuring made-in-Oklahoma (MIO) foods, beverages, arts, decor, and furniture. Veteran Oklahoma restaurateurs Tom and Cindy Harsha, and Chris Potts, announced the grand re-opening of Meridian Market will be held May 1, 2021, from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. at 2037 S. Meridian. The original opening in October 2020, was understandably dampened by the pandemic, but on-going safety protocols have continued to allow patrons to enjoy delicious dine-in, curbside, delivery, or grab-and-go fare. The May 1 Made-in-Oklahoma Festival is the perfect way to engage the community in supporting locally owned food partners and artisans in their booths and pop-ups, both inside and outside of Meridian Market Restaurant.

Modern spins on classic foods, featuring Upside Down Pizza, make up Meridian Market's eclectic menu. Starters range from a Southern Caprese Salad made with green fried tomatoes to Quail Tips basted with MIO Peach Habanero Jam. Made-from-scratch soups are available daily in the restaurant or for grab-and-go. Unique salads, sandwiches and burgers also include vegetarian options. The dinner menu offers steaks, pork loin chops, seafood and chicken served with homemade sides like au gratin potatoes, blood orange heirloom carrots, Brussels sprouts, and baked mac and cheese, while delicious desserts vary daily. The wine and coffee bar, lined with individual charging stations, features local craft beers, wines from Oklahoma wineries, signature cocktails using in-state distillery spirits, and craft coffees with locally roasted beans. Professional catering services are also available. And recently, Meridian Market has partnered with the Healthy Living OKC wellness center in NW Oklahoma City, offering grab-and-go items to its members.

"In keeping with the Oklahoma standard, we have strived to keep our local economy thriving in as many ways as we are able," explained Cindy Harsha "By supporting these outstanding local food companies and artisans, we are able to provide hope and enjoyment for our fellow Oklahomans, as well as travelers from around the country."
